Annual General Meeting

16th Jun 2012

At the AGM there was considerable discussion on matters concerning Division 2 of the Shoulder-to-Shoulder League. As a result, a decision taken by the League Secretary last October was overturned and all the cards for one shooter representing Watsonians as a substitute for a nominated team member in three of its matches were disqualified as it was considered that he did not satisfy the rule governing the use of substitutes. The points were recalculated and Pathhead B consequently take over as winners of the division.

Once again, no County Captain was elected, so there will be no county teams again next season.

Of the eight qualifiers, only 6 could make it, and the organiser decided that instead of anyone getting a bye straight into the final, all six would shoot a preliminary round with the best four going forward to the semi-final. The result of the preliminary shoot was:

Commonwealth Cities Match 2011

27th Mar 2012

Diligent observers might have noticed that the result of this match has not yet been given here or posted in the County teams page as it usually is. This is not an oversight.

The Edinburgh team shot its cards on 4th April last year. The match period ended on 30th September as usual and the result is normally announced by the NSRA in early November. That time came and went with no result forthcoming. Our contact did not make any immediate enquiries as it was known that the NSRA were having staffing issues (experienced personnel having left and new staff were still bedding in) so left it till earlier this year. Apparently the result had been issued at about the normal time, and Edinburgh was not mentioned anywhere, even as a non-return, and we obviously did not receive a copy. This was queried enthusiastically, and after some time it emerged that despite extensive searches the NSRA could not find Edinburgh's cards. It was admitted eventually that we had actually entered, but there was no record of our cards or our scores.

At this distance from the match period, it is unlikely that anything will be done about this situation. The person who sent Edinburgh's cards off did not obtain a certificate of posting, so that avenue is closed. If there are any developments, they will be given here as soon as they are known. The estimated scores are available in the County teams link on the left.

As previously intimated, the 2011 Cities & Boroughs match was cancelled by the NSRA due to lack of entries.

It is not known by this writer whether either of these two competitions will be entered by Edinburgh this year, or even if they will be run by the NSRA at all as entries have been very low in recent years. When he knows, you will too.

Shoulder-to-Shoulder League

20th Mar 2012

Division 1 of the S/S league still has one match to go which will not affect the final placings, but the top two teams have completed their programme and have tied on 16 points each. This means that Balerno & Currie and Selkirk will have to shoot off to decide the title. Pathhead will be 3rd and Heriot's 4th. The date of the shoot-off still has to be decided.

There are still a couple of matches to go in Division 2, but the leaders cannot now be caught and Watsonians will win this division.

The 'Champion of Champions' match between the two divisional winners will be arranged in due course. This match is run on the Macrae handicap system.

Team Postal League

18th Mar 2012

The final round of the Team Postal League has just been completed and the winners are now known:

Division 1 was won by Pentland. The team from Caithness who came so close last season went one better this time, only losing two matches, one where they were a man short, and had the best average. Balerno & Currie pipped Watsonians for second on gunscore.

Division 2 was won by Orkney, who won all their matches (the only team in the league to do so), taking the win from Leven & Dist whose only losses were to the team from Kirkwall.

Division 3 was taken by Watsonians B. Redcraig were second by a point, but the winners were well ahead on aggregate.

In **Division 4**, Edinburgh Civil Service won all the right matches to win by a distance from Kinross & Milnathort, who had a better average and inflicted ECS's only defeat in the last round.

Division 5 was won by Wishaw from their near-neighbours Lanark ESM. Wishaw have been in this competition only two seasons, and have won their division both times.

The best average award (the Duncan Cup) goes to Alasdair Horne of Balerno & Currie, just in front of clubmate Sinclair Bruce (99.3 to 99.2). Last year's winner Eric Brown of Selkirk was third with 99.0. The winner of the Best Improvement award (the Smith Shield) goes to Jack Sime of George Watson's College for a 47.8% improvement in his average from last season.

One competitor was disqualified and there were four no-returns so it's hardly a qualifying competition where everybody qualifies. No doubt there will be call-offs from the Final, as there always are, so it will be another poorly attended farce as there are no reserves to fill vacated spots. It's getting to the stage where it is not worth running these competitions if they are not supported.

Mary MacDonald

17th Sept 2011

It is with sadness that I have to report the death last Thursday of Mary MacDonald. She was 78 and had been ill for some time. Mary was an official of the LSSA in the 1970s-80s period along with her late husband Bill and served as Treasurer for a couple years and was also the Air Weapons Secretary. She was also heavily involved in the organisation of the Scottish Pistol Association and was a member of the long-defunct Hewlett Packard shooting club in South Queensferry where she lived, and afterwards shot at Redcraig. She was the Lothian Ladies Prone Champion in 1971, 1981 and 1982.

The funeral will be held at Falkirk Crematorium on Thursday 22nd September at 1.30pm, followed by a reception at the Two Bridges Restaurant in South Queensferry at 3pm to which all her shooting friends are invited.
